- Submission deadline: 15 August 2022
- The review process is double-blinded. Papers are reviewed by Members of the DDF Academic Board in August – September 2022
- Presentations: 22 or 23 September 2022

The submission policies are:

- 1. Accepted languages are German and English.
- 2. Authors should be listed in alphabetical order (and not linked to an academic hierarchy).
- 3. NO changes in the paper title, abstract, authorship, and actual paper can occur AFTER the submission deadline.
- 4. The paper and the submission form must be submitted via submission form on https://davosdigitalforum.ch/academic-track-22/ Deadline is 15 August 2022

The formatting guidelines include:

- 1. The entire submission (title page in Title Case, abstract, text, figures, graphs, tables, and references) must be contained in one document. Number all of the pages of the paper.
- 2. The maximum length of the submission is 30 pages (including title page and all figures, graphs, tables, appendices, and references.).
- 3. Use Times New Roman 12-point font, double spaced, and 2.5 cm margin all around.
- 4. To facilitate the blind review process, remove ALL author-identifying information from your submission document. Note: You will still include ALL authors associated with your submission in the submission form, but not in your paper. The author information will appear in the Conference Proceedings.
- 5. Check that the paper is converted and print correctly (i.e. all imported figures and tables are there).
- 6. Upload a PDF version of your paper.
- 7. Regarding order, structure and format of your paper, follow the APA Guidelines (https://apastyle.apa.org/style-grammar-guidelines/paper-format).
